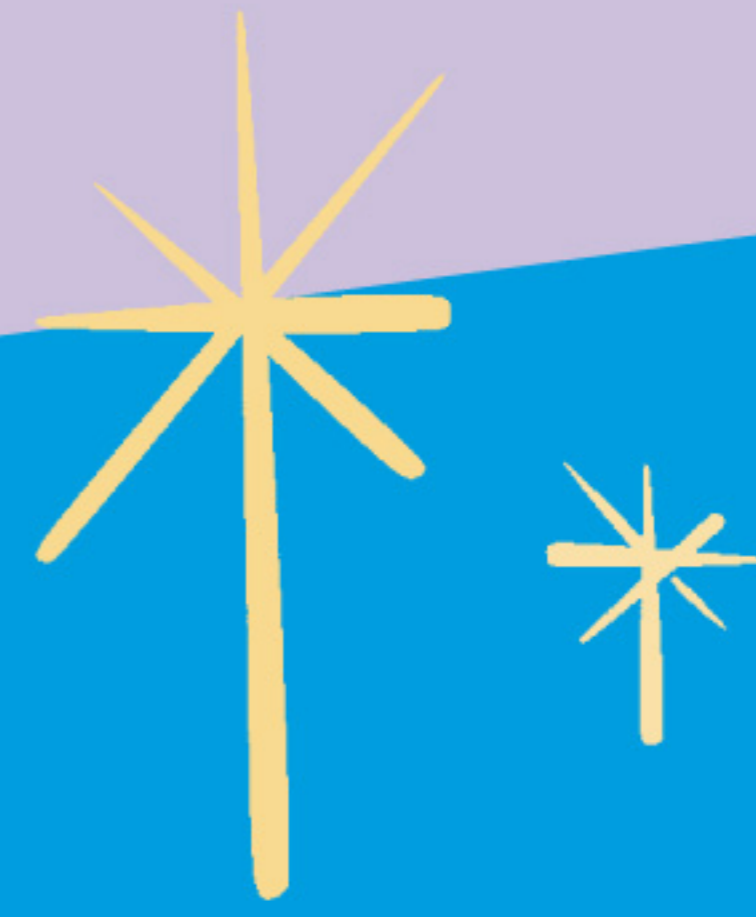


Swingin' slang from the sixties



A
